Gift Certificate Form

What is a Gift Certificate?

We provide workshops or services that you purchase for persons of your choosing. The minimum certificate value is \$30. Car pooling is not included. Call if you need more clarification: 503-775-3828. Examples of certificates:

1. Workshop Certificates: \$30 - \$50 /person/event. Sliding scale for gifter. Admission to any of our regular day workshops. Giftee chooses. For Gifting Rendezvous, see the pricing at our Rendezvous pages.
2. Open Certificates: Order certificates of any amount (\$30 minimum) that can be used towards workshops, rendezvous, phone consultations, on site visits, or publications. The Giftee is responsible to cover the cost of completing the purchase.
3. On-Site Consulting/Workshop Certificates: \$400 for an onsite visit to a public site or someone's private land within Portland, for up to a 3-hour event for 1 to 15 attendees. For drives longer than 10 minutes, add \$1/minute (NOT mile) of travel time (based on Google maps round trip to and from Wild Food Adventures).

Responsibility of Gifter (You):

While gift certificates are often bought well in advance, they can also be last minute gifts paid for after the giving (useful for last minute situations). The important thing is to pay for them as soon as possible since that gift can only be honored once you have paid us for that gift. If you forget to pay and register that gift with us, it can be humiliating to both you the recipient for them to be told that the gift does not exist. The moral to the story is to pay for and register any last minute gifts as soon as you can around the time of the gift giving. Any certificate or card you use to represent the gift in is only a memento; it has no real value. The actual gift is registered with us and will be in our records under the name(s) of the recipient(s).

Responsibility of Recipient:

For workshop certificates, each recipient is required to:

1. To call us at least 10 days in advance of the desired workshop to verify the gift and to properly register for the workshop(s) they plan to attend. Failure to do so may limit their options if workshops fill before they notify us.
2. Sign a waiver form prior to attending. Due to liability issues, children must be accompanied by an adult.
3. While their workshop is paid for by you, there may be an small additional fee if your giftee participates in car-pooling to longer distance workshops.
